## August 21, 2020 Erie County, Ohio Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) update

Total number of cases of COVID-19 in Erie County, Ohio	708 (+17)
Total number of laboratory-confirmed cases	627 (+20)
Total number of probable cases	81 (-3)
Total number of COVID-19 deaths in Erie County, Ohio	32
Total number of laboratory-confirmed deaths	31
Total number of probable deaths	1
