## April 13, 2020 Erie County, Ohio Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) update

As of Monday, April 13, 2020, there are no new confirmed or probable cases of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in Erie County, Ohio. The total number of cases of COVID-19 in Erie County, Ohio is 13, and one (1) Erie County, Ohio resident has died as a result of COVID-19.

Firelands Regional Health System is currently treating four (4) hospitalized patients from Erie County and the surrounding areas who have tested positive for COVID-19 and has a total of 78 patients hospitalized for various reasons.
