

HEALTH ALERT Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19): Updated Guidance for Reporting

October 20, 2020

Summary and Action Items

- To address the evolving response, the Interim Director of the Ohio Department of Health (ODH)
 has issued an amended Director's Journal Entry with updated reporting requirements for COVID19. This updated document is attached.
- For current guidance on case classification of COVID-19 for surveillance purposes, please refer to the ODH Infectious Disease Control Manual.

Amended Reporting Requirements for COVID-19

On October 20, 2020, Lance Himes, ODH Interim Director, issued an amended Director's Journal Entry for COVID-19. The reporting requirements have been amended to include the electronic reporting of all laboratory results related to SARS-CoV-2:

- Persons in charge of any laboratory that examines specimens of human origin for evidence of COVID-19 infection shall <u>electronically report</u> within twenty-four (24) hours the results of all such examination, including, but not limited to: positive, negative, invalid, and inconclusive results.
- Laboratory results should be electronically reported according to the protocols outlined for <u>COVID-19</u> reporting on the ODH Electronic Laboratory Reporting website.

Case Classification and Infection Prevention and Control

The ODH <u>Infectious Disease Control Manual</u> (IDCM) provides guidance on infectious diseases from a public health perspective. Please refer to the <u>COVID-19 Chapter</u> in Section 3 of the IDCM for details on classifying cases for reporting and surveillance purposes, as well as recommendations for public health management to prevent and control the spread of SARS-CoV-2. This document is updated frequently as new information becomes available.
