April 4, 2020 Erie County, Ohio Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) update

As of Saturday, April 4, 2020, there are no new Erie County, Ohio residents who have tested positive for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). The total number of COVID-19 cases in Erie County, Ohio is six (6), and the total number of deaths is one (1). Firelands Regional Health System is currently treating five (5) hospitalized patients from Erie County and the surrounding areas who have tested positive for COVID-19, and has a total of 101 hospitalized patients. The Erie County Health Department and Firelands Regional Health System continue to work closely to identify and test potential cases.
