April 7, 2020 Erie County, Ohio Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) update

As of Tuesday, April 7, 2020, the total number of positive cases of COVID-19 in Erie County, Ohio remains unchanged with a total of ten (10) positive cases and one (1) resident who has died from COVID-19.

The Erie County Health Department and Firelands Regional Health System continue to work closely to identify and test potential cases. Firelands Regional Health System is currently treating four (4) hospitalized patients from Erie County and the surrounding areas who have tested positive for COVID-19, and currently has a total of 99 patients who are hospitalized for various reasons.
