April 11, 2020 Erie County, Ohio Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) update

As of Saturday, April 11, 2020, Erie County, Ohio has a total of ten (10) residents who have received laboratory-confirmed positive test results for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and one (1) Erie County, Ohio resident has died from COVID-19. There are currently no probable cases in Erie County. A probable case is defined as an individual who has symptoms of COVID-19 and is a close personal contact of someone who has received laboratory-confirmed positive test results for COVID-19.

The Erie County Health Department and Firelands Regional Health System continue to work closely to identify and test potential cases. Firelands Regional Health System is currently treating four (4) hospitalized patients from Erie County and the surrounding areas who have tested positive for COVID-19 and has a total of 89 patients who are hospitalized for various reasons.
